Cathy explores the beauty in everyday life at cafes, farmers' markets, grocery stores, and street scenes. Rarely is anything posed. Her medium is acrylic on canvas or board.

Cathy paints and has an active psychotherapy practice. She finds that "both art and therapy provide fertile ground for the painter and the viewer, the client and the therapist to communicate and enrich each other."

Raised in Louisville, Kentucky, Cathy received a BFA in studio art from the University of Michigan and her MSSW from Raymond A. Kent School of Social Work.
